- * 17 boys and 29 girls in primary school
- * 32 boys and 14 girls in secondary school
- * 3 boys and 4 girls in college or university
- * 13 boys in skills training

- * 3 boys not yet in school
- * 5 young adults
- * 52 skills-training students at the Raithithi Polytechnic
